DEBTOR'S APPLICATION TO EMPLOY MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C.
AS ACCOUNTANT

To the HONORABLE HENRY J. BOROFF, Bankruptcy Judge:

Now comes your Applicant, HAMPDEN COUNTY PHYSICIAN ASSOCIATES, LLC ("Debtor"), the Debtor in the above-captioned matter, and it does hereby move this Court, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 327, for the entry of an Order authorizing the employment of the firm of MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C. as accountant to the Debtor. In support of this Application, the Debtor represents as follows:

1. On October 2, 2014, your Applicant filed a Voluntary Petition under the provisions of Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code ("Bankruptcy Code") with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Massachusetts ("Bankruptcy Court").

2. Pursuant to the provisions of §§ 1107 and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Debtor has continued to operate its business and manage its business affairs as a Debtor-in-Possession. No Trustee or Examiner has been requested or appointed.

3. The Debtor is a multi-specialist physician group engaged in the practice of medicine in Western Massachusetts.

Its approximately sixty-eight (68) healthcare providers serve about 55,000 patients. The business enterprise employs a total of approximately 300 individuals and operates fourteen (14) offices primarily located throughout Hampden County, Massachusetts. In addition, the Debtor and its staff serve patients at local hospitals, skilled-nursing facilities, and long-term care facilities. The Debtor operates its own laboratory, sleep disorder center, and urgent care center.

4. The Debtor desires to employ the firm of MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C. to provide such accounting services as may be required by the Debtor during the administration of this case.

5. The Debtor anticipates that the services to be provided by Meyers Brothers Kalicka, P.C. will include:

a) Oversight of the internal accounting systems employed by the Debtor;

b) Preparation of federal and state tax returns;

c) Preparation of audited year-end financial statements;

d) Assisting the Debtor and other professionals employed in the case to prepare a Plan of Reorganization to be filed with the Court;

e) Assisting the Debtor and its professionals in preparing and reviewing financial projections;

f) Assisting the Debtor with in administration of its 401(k) retirement plan including preparing certain tax forms and reviewing audits;

g) Assisting the Debtor in complying with the Operational Guidelines and Reporting Requirements promulgated by the Office

of the United States Trustee; and

h) Providing such additional financial analysis, projections, and other accounting and tax services as may be required.

6. The Debtor seeks to employ MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C. because the firm has provided accounting services to the Debtor for more than ten (10) years and is familiar with the Debtor's financial records and systems; the firm is uniquely suited to provide the services required. As a result of its relationship with the Debtor, the services to be provided can be rendered in a cost effective and efficient manner without the need of a long learning curve.

7. Subject to approval of this Court under § 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, compensation will be payable to the firm of MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C. on an hourly basis plus actual and necessary expenses incurred by the firm in connection with the case. The hourly rates to be charged are consistent with the rates charged to other clients in non-bankruptcy matters.

8. The hourly billing rates of members and employees of the firm of MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C. are:

9. MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C. will apply to the Bankruptcy Court for interim and final allowances of fees and reimbursement of expenses in accordance with applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Local Bankruptcy Rules of the

Bankruptcy Court, Orders of this Court, and the fee guidelines promulgated by the Office of the United States Trustee.

10. As of the Petition Date, the Debtor did not owe MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C. any amount for accounting services rendered prior to the Petition Date.

11. To the best of your Applicant's knowledge and belief and based on the appended Statement of Professional Person, MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C. does not hold or represent any interest adverse to the Estate, members of the firm are disinterested persons within the meaning of §§ 327(a) and 101 of the Bankruptcy Code, and its employment would be in the best interest of this Estate.

WHEREFORE, your Applicant respectfully requests that it be authorized to employ MEYERS BROTHERS KALICKA, P.C. as its accountant and for such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
